From 1984 to 1990, Monika Griefahn was the first woman to serve on the International Board of Greenpeace. From 1990 to 1998, she served as Environment Minister in Lower Saxony. Then as now, she advocated for a new energy policy: for renewable energies and the phase-out of nuclear energy. From 2012 to 2018, Monika Griefahn was also Director of Environment and Society at the cruise line AIDA Cruises. She played a key role in the company's realignment toward the use of liquefied natural gas as a ship fuel.
